Dear Parents/Carers,

We are so looking forward to our Stage 3 camp to Canberra Week 2 next term.

The Department of Education has updated school's COVID management for excursions and have provided recommendations on how we must conduct our camp in this regard.

After carefully reading these updated procedures, please sign the note and return to school.

These forms must be returned to the school by Thursday 7th April.

I acknowledge that this event is required to be held in accordance with any current NSW Health COVID-19 Public Health Orders and the NSW Department of Education's policies and procedures. Parents and carers will be notified of any changes in Term 2 Week 2.

I acknowledge and accept that there is a risk that my child may be exposed to COVID-19 whilst attending and participating at this event.

I confirm that my child will **not** attend if displaying any symptoms of illness, and/or if directed to isolate under public health orders.

Students are recommended to take a COVID test prior to arriving at school to depart for camp.

- if positive, the student **MUST** stay home.
- if unwell, the student **MUST** stay home.
- students CAN attend if they are WELL and do not have symptoms.

If a student develops symptoms while on camp, their family will be contacted to collect their child and have them tested. The school will not be testing students for COVID.

If the student then tests positive, students in the same room group of the positive student are considered close contacts. A decision will be made on the continuing participation of these close contacts based on the following criteria;

- The close contact has had COVID since the 9th Feb 2022 (12 weeks prior to the camp) and is symptom free. These close contacts are not required to isolate and may continue to participate in the camp.
- The close contact has had COVID since the 9th Feb 2022 (12 weeks prior to the camp) but has developed symptoms. These students have to be collected by their family and contact NSW Health to discuss isolation requirements.
- The close contact has not had COVID since the 9th Feb 2022. These students will have to be collected by their family and enter a 7 day isolation.

If any student tests positive after returning from camp, the school must be notified. Close contacts will be informed and will be required to isolate.

To help us identify the category that best suits your child, please indicate if your child has had Covid in the last 12 weeks and include the date of their positive notification to NSW Health. This information will be checked against school records.
