Reward systems Updated January 2025

PBL tokens

These tokens encourage our students to work together towards a whole school reward.

- *All staff (teachers, admin, SLSOs) will hand out unlimited PBL tokens as fast and frequent feedback to students for demonstrating the 3 positive values of Respect, Responsibility and Safety. These are given in all areas of the school.*
- *Students place Tokens with their name and class on the back, in their class box after each break.*
- *Each Friday afternoon, Tokens will be randomly drawn from the class box, (two from each mainstream class, one from each support class). These students will select a gift from the prize box in the office.*
- *The Token boxes will be emptied into Pacey's nesting box on Friday afternoon.*
- *Once these tokens reach the specified height in the nesting box, all students will receive a whole school reward (as agreed by staff and students). This may occur at various times throughout the year.*

Merit system

These awards encourage our students to be the best they can be in all of their learning.

- *Merits awards will be awarded each week for stand-out positive behaviour, kindness, improvement, effort or application in any curriculum area in the classroom, by the class teacher.*
- *PBL merit awards can also be issued for stand-out demonstration of the school values or weekly focus in the areas of Respect, Responsibility or Safety.*
- *RFF, learning support and Library teachers can award merits, in consultation with the classroom teacher.*
- *The Principal can award Principal Awards at their discretion. These will count as merit awards.*
- *100% attendance awards will be handed out each term. These will count as merit awards.*
- *Students will collect and store their merits in a book/folder. This book can be decorated if desired.*

- *Once students have reached Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum level, they can submit their book at the front office.*
- *Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum awards will be presented at the next Friday morning assembly. Parents/carers are welcome to attend.*
- *Teachers will keep track of merits at the classroom level in the School Bytes system. The Principal will track Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, 100% attendance awards and Principal Awards.*
- *The merit award system will begin anew at the beginning of each year.*

Bronze: 10

- *Collect ten FRPS Merits.*
- *Bronze Certificate presented at assembly.*
- *Photo displayed on Bronze wall in hall.*

Silver: 15

- *Collect fifteen FRPS Merits.*
- *Silver Certificate presented at assembly.*
- *Principal morning / afternoon tea.*
- *Photo displayed on Silver wall in hall.*

Gold: 20

- *Collect twenty FRPS Merits.*
- *Gold Certificate presented at assembly.*
- *Name and photo in the Newsletter in the 'Honour Roll.'*
- *Thirty minutes visiting a room of their choice.*
- *Photo displayed on Gold wall in hall.*

Platinum: 30

- *Collect thirty FRPS Merits.*
- *Platinum Certificate presented at assembly.*
- *Name and photo in the Newsletter in the 'Honour Roll.'*
- *Special 'Platinum pin' awarded.*
- *Photo displayed on Platinum wall in hall.*
- *Receive a Book Club voucher.*
