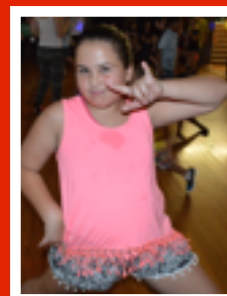
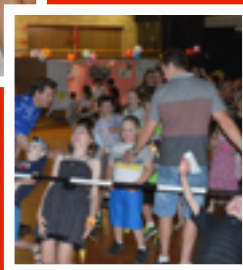

Wollongong Science Centre Excursion

Dear Parents/Carers,

This term Stage 2 has been completing a Science unit titled *The Seasons*. To accompany this topic, we have organised an excursion to the Wollongong Science Centre and Planetarium. At the Science Centre students will have the opportunity to view Science and Planetarium shows as well as participate in some hands on activities.

The excursion will be Monday 7th of December (Week 10) and will be go for the whole day. Students will get the bus from school at 10am and have recess at the grassed area at the Science Centre before entering and have lunch after the presentations. The bus will return students back to school by 2.30pm.

The cost will be \$15 per student, which covers the bus and entrance to the Science Centre. Students will need to bring a hat, recess snack, lunch and water bottle in their normal school bag. Students must wear full school uniform.

The Science Centre has also asked if they may photograph students interacting with the exhibits and enjoying the science shows. These photos will be used for future excursion guides and brochures (no student names would be published). If you are happy for your child to be photographed, please indicate on the permission slip.
