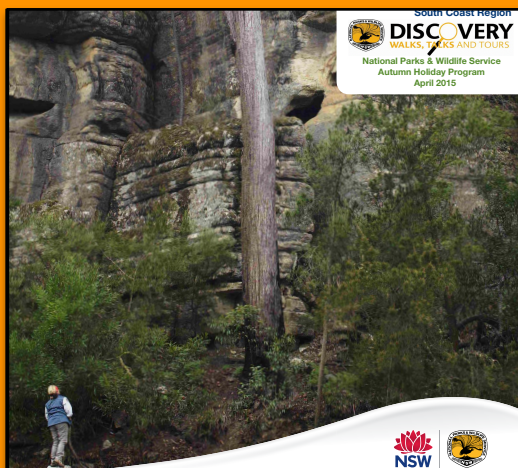

What is Discovery?

National Parks and Wildlife Service's environmental education program is called Discovery. Through our walks, trips and tours we aim to foster enjoyment of our national parks and provide visitors with an opportunity to see how we manage reserves for natural and cultural heritage conservation and recreation.

Note to participants:

Bookings are required to secure places in the activities. Printed finishing times are approximate and activities may be cancelled or altered due to unforeseen circumstances.
Children must be accompanied by a supervising adult (the child rate is for children aged 5-16 years; children under 5 years attend free). Family rates are for 2 adults and up to 3 children.

When attending activities, please bring drinking water, appropriate clothing (particularly footwear), sun protection and a snack. Vehicle entry fees apply in some parks.
