Hints and Tips No. 7: Getting to school on time



It is essential to establish a regular routine each morning and arriving at school on time is an important part of your child's morning routine.

- It sets up good habits for the future.
- It provides social benefits – good play time and discussion among friends.
- The school day usually begins with the teacher giving out information to students. Eg. Any changes to school routines, coming events etc.
- It is an opportunity for important teacher pupil interaction before school.
- There is plenty of time for ordering lunches if needed.

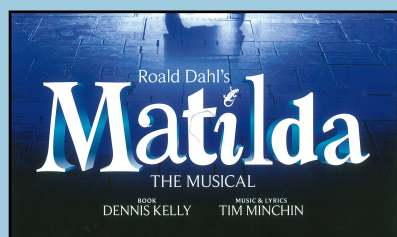
Cordials, soft drinks and sports drinks

Cordials, soft drinks and sports drinks should be avoided, and only consumed on special occasions and in small amounts. These drinks contain lots of sugar (between 4 to 6 teaspoons of sugar in every 250ml cup) and often also contain artificial colourings and flavourings as well as caffeine. Too much of these drinks can lead to weight gain and tooth decay. They are also expensive and add unnecessary cost to the weekly food budget.

Children who are frequently late to school find it more difficult to settle in to class routines. Please ensure your child/ren arrive to school prior to 9am. 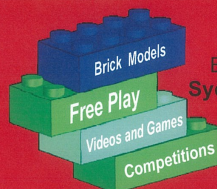

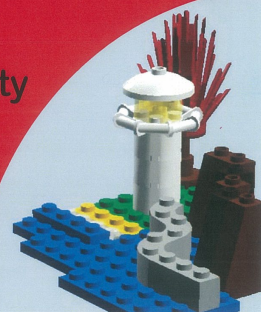

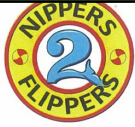
