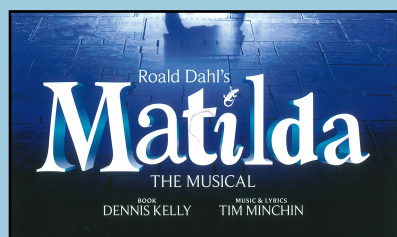

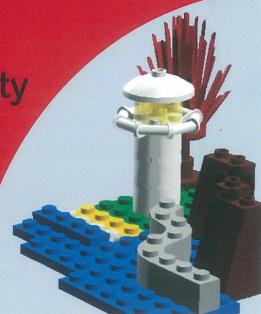

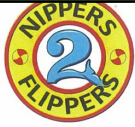

Year 5 Students from Berkeley, Berkeley West and Farmborough Rd Public Schools have been visiting on a Thursday to ISH and taking part in the Science 5 x 5 Challenge days. Students spend the day doing Science experiments and learning new and exciting skills under the direction of Mr James Murada. Students have one more session this week and on the 18th June they have a graduation ceremony with their parents.

One of the students from Berkeley Public School shared his experiences of last weeks challenge. "The 5x5 challenges have been really fascinating. Mr Murada taught us about volcanoes, crystals and bunsen burners. I wish that was every day. First up the bunsen burners have been amazing!!! And my first time lighting a match. We're making paper mache volcanoes. Crystals have been awesome so far. If lava is cooled very quickly, tiny crystals appear. If its cooled slow, large crystals appear and if it is cooled at an even pace little specks appear. I wish I could come to Illawarra Sports High every day of the week." Jett Pertovt -5/6T.
