

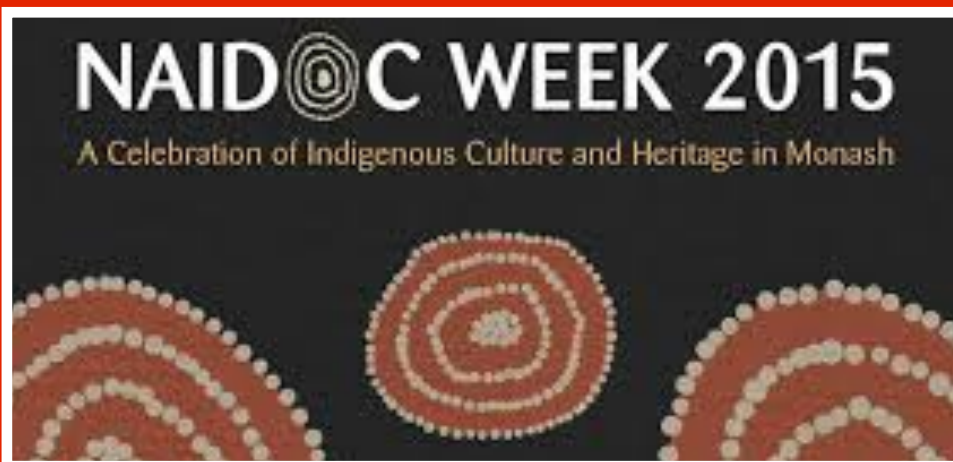

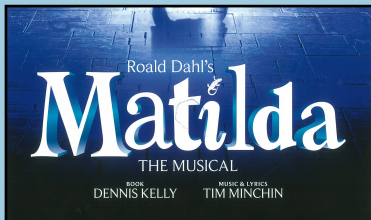
Information Night
