Going to school is important. It makes learning easier for your child and helps build and maintain friendships with other children.

- Keep your child home only when they are sick.
- Advise the school of any absence.
- See doctors and dentists after school times.

Friends are important.

- Show an interest in your child's friends
- Invite friends to come and play
- Encourage your child to play with other children.

Helping your child have a happy day at school is important for you and your child.

If you are having difficulties in getting your child to school you should contact the principal as soon as possible to discuss the problem and ask for help.

The principal may ask a Home School Liaison Officer to contact you for further assistance and advice.

- Or send a CD / DVD / Memory Stick with the photo in .jpg format 300kB or larger.
  - label or include a file with name of child, school, class and quantity ordered
- Only send a printed photo (5x3 or larger) if you cannot send in digital format.
  - home printed photos are often not suitable for scanning and/or enlarging
