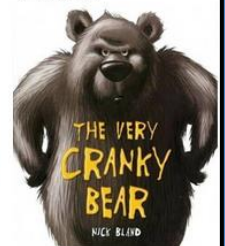

Merinda - Dark coloured clothes. Eg black t-shirt, black shorts/skirt/tights or jeans.

Yangah - Multi colours - any colour t-shirt (no singlets) and any colour for bottoms - shorts or pants. Reindeer headbands or christmas earrings. Ribbons can also be worn.

Matong - Any clothing that has a Christmas theme (green, white, red etc) eg: Christmas themed t-shirts.

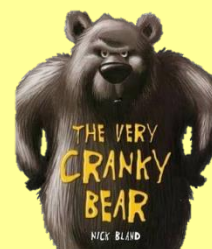
Coolangatta - White Tops (t-shirts or singlets) and black shorts or tights
