Coding Club

The Farmborough Road Coding Club is back! Students in Stage 2 and 3 are invited to join this club this term. Younger students will be invited later in the year.

Coding Club will be held on Thursdays at Lunch 1. Students will use a web-based software application called Scratch to code or make their own stories/games. Prior coding knowledge is not necessary. You will need to create a free Scratch account for your child. This will allow programming activities to be saved and accessed at home or in the next coding session at school. Please set up the account with your email; not the child's school email account (just for privacy issues). The student will need to know the username and password that you set up so they can use it at school. Create an account at <https://scratch.mit.edu/> (Students can create codes without an account but will not be able to save their work.)
