## ***Coding club***

Year 3 - 6 students have had the opportunity to join the coding Club at school on Thursdays Lunch 1. We are a registered group with Code Club Australia who run a coding event, called Moonhack, which our students can participate in.

Started by Code Club Australia, Moonhack is the Record Setter event that is achieved by kids all over the globe. In 2016, 10,207 Australian kids participated, with the idea being to inspire kids to participate widely in digital technologies, inspiring kids to believe in their ability to aim for the moon. In 2017 Code Club aimed higher than the year before, and reached 28,575 kids! This year kids from every village, every city and school or home around the world, will get the chance to collaborate and code to beat the record once again on July 20! Celebrate inclusion in STEM, diversity in technology and the opportunity to achieve big things through education when we work together. ## Friday Canteen Volunteers Required!

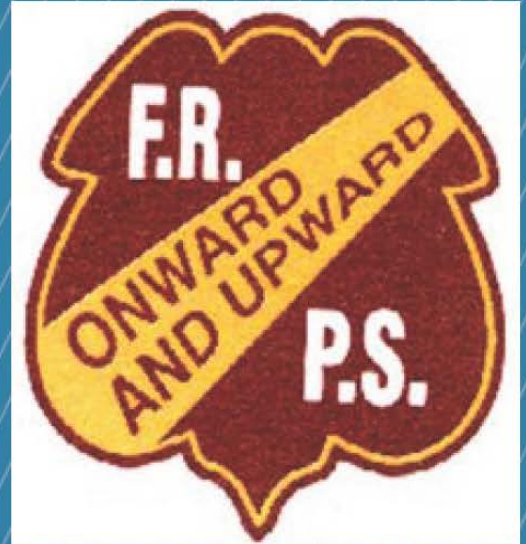

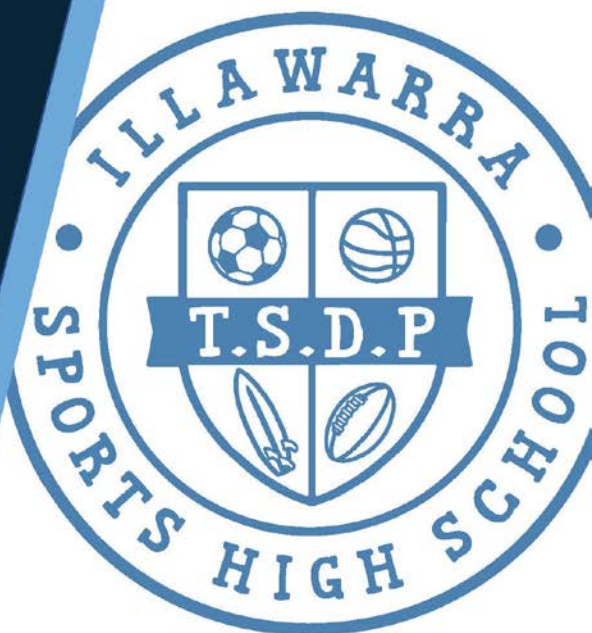
