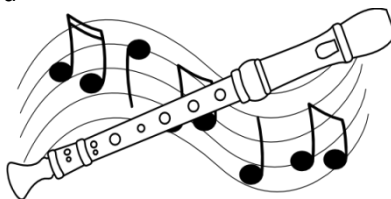

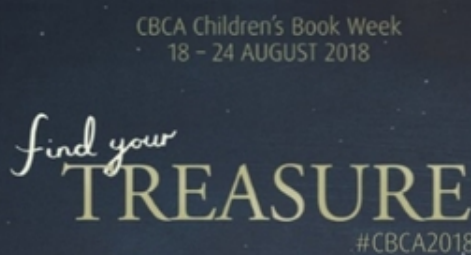
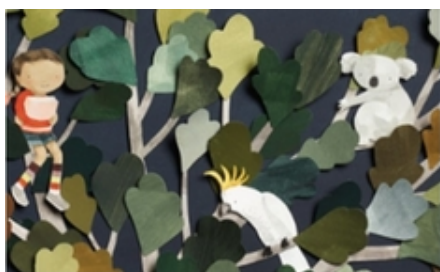


Find Your Treasure!
