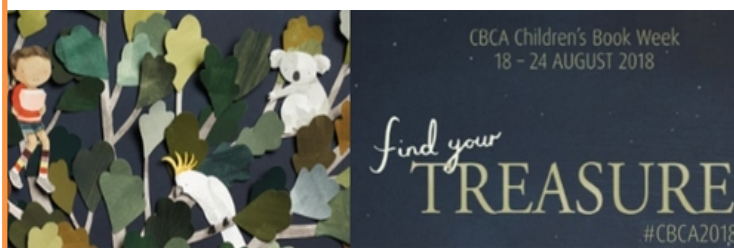


## Book Week
