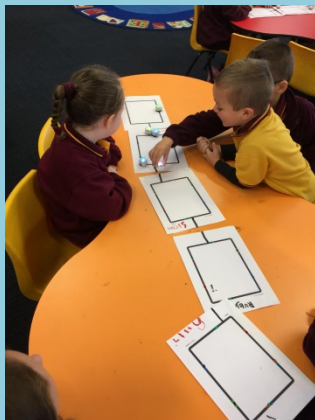

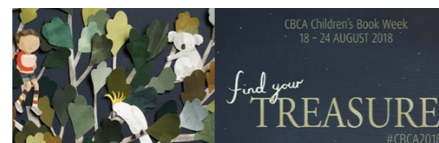


It's time to Find Your Treasure!

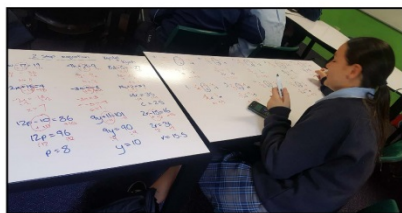
